We also wanted to raise awareness of the 988 suicide and crisis telephone number, a new dialing code authorized by Congress in 2020 available to anyone suffering from a suicidal crisis and available 24/7.

EQUITY, INCLUSION & DIVERSITY UPDATES

This month we will highlight National Hispanic Heritage Month. This is a time of celebration, but for Mental Health Professionals, also a time for reflection on persistent and deep disparities in access to effective treatment.

Bilingual patients are evaluated differently when evaluated in English versus Spanish, and Latinx/Hispanic people are more frequently undertreated for Mental Health symptoms than white people, with language being identified as one of the largest obstacles to treatment and underscoring the need for more Spanish-speaking providers.
